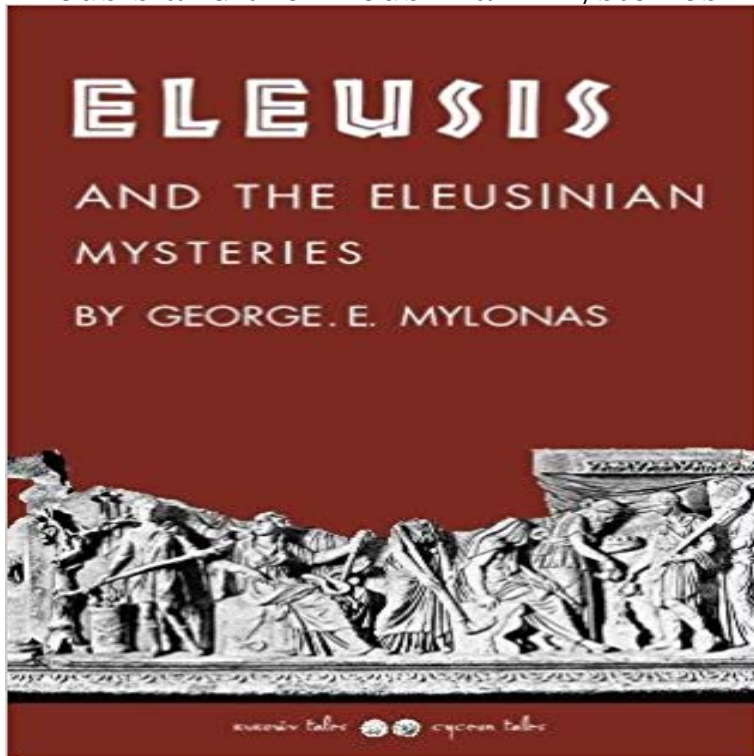


Eleusis and the Eleusinian Mysteries



The real excavations in Eleusis start in 1882 by the Archaeological Society of Athens, supported by the Greek Government, since in 1877 they had started to disappropriate the village houses that they were all over the place. The first director was Dem. Philios, who was supported by a German architect, named Dorpfeld. Dem. Philios worked in Eleusis till 1894. Andreas Skias took over the leadership and he worked till 1907, when he became a professor in the University of Athens and it was impossible to continue in Eleusis. Excavations started again in 1917 under Kon.Kourouniotis responsibility, always with Archaeological Society of Athens. He cooperated with G.Mylonas, I.Travlos and I.Threpsiades. These three continued after Kourouniotis death in 1945. G.Mylonas, until his death, in 1985 was involved in studies and researches about Eleusis.
