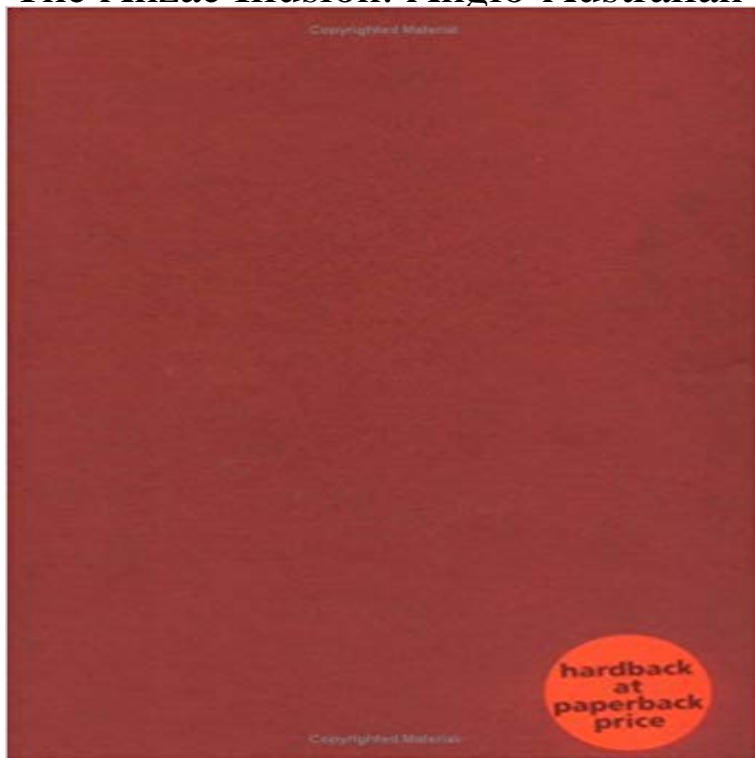


The Anzac Illusion: Anglo-Australian Relations during World War I
