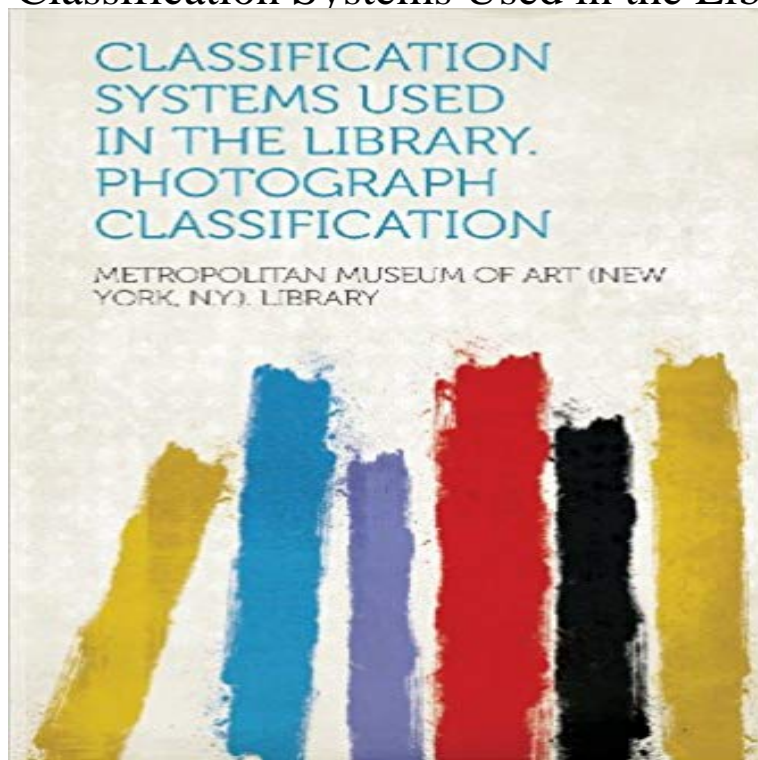


## Classification Systems Used in the Library. Photograph Classification
