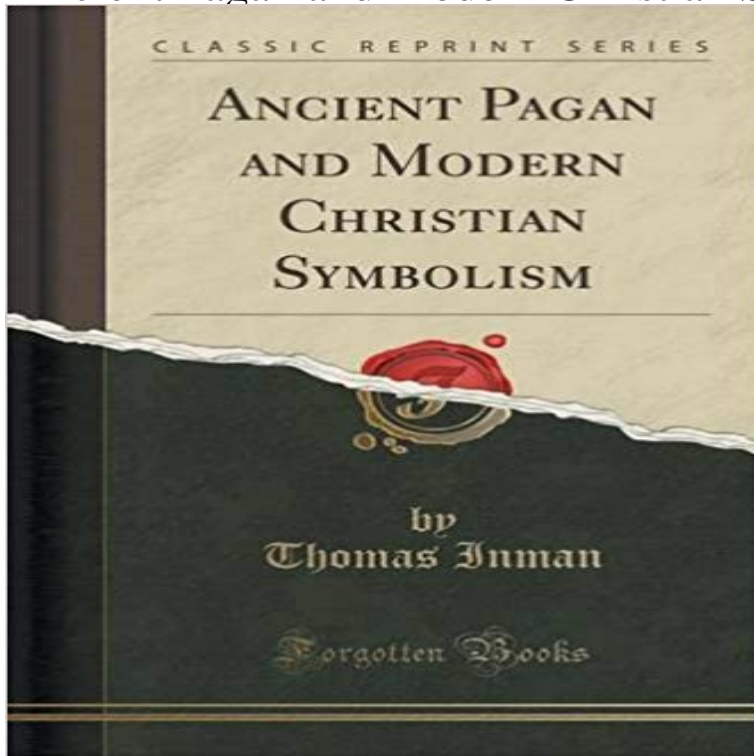


## Ancient Pagan and Modern Christian Symbolism (Classic Reprint)
