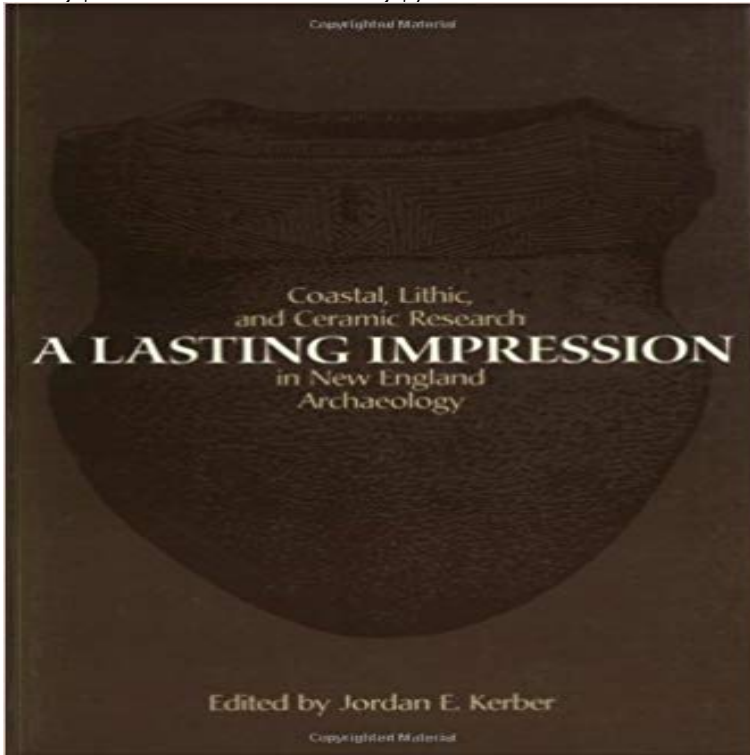


A Lasting Impression: Coastal, Lithic, and Ceramic Research in New England Archaeology
