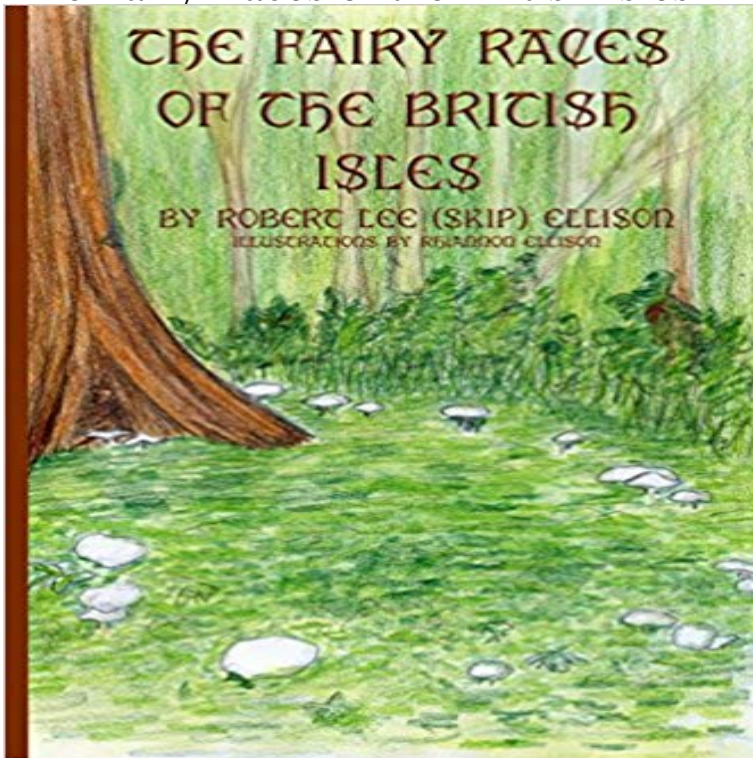


The Fairy Races of the British Isles
