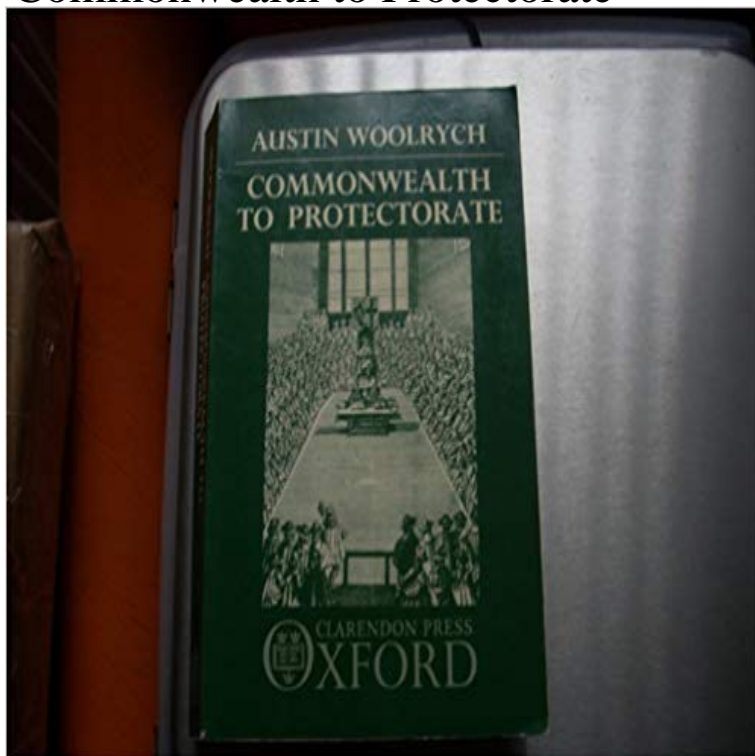


Commonwealth to Protectorate
