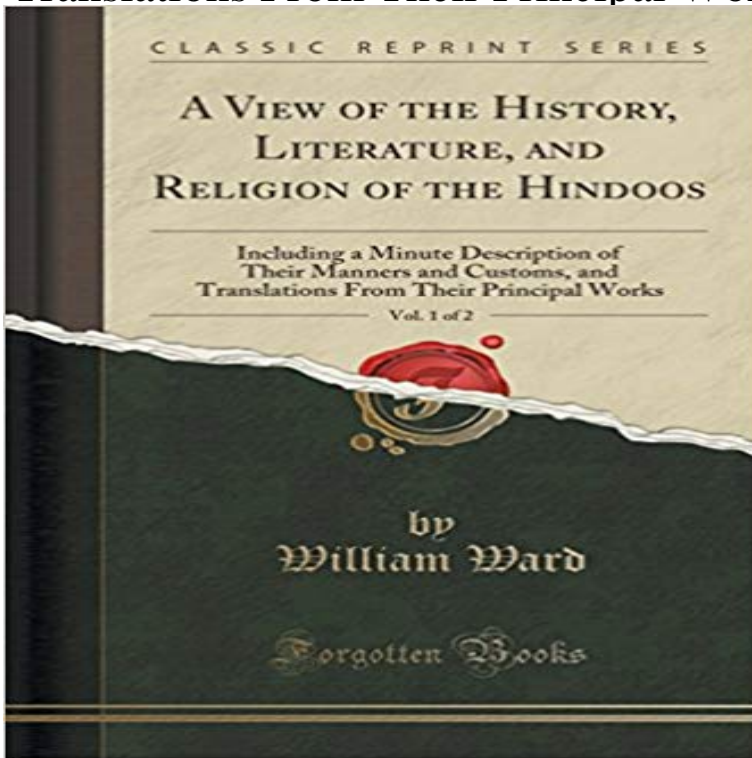

If the reader will only retain in his memory, that the short u is to be sounded as the short o in son, or the u in Burton; the French e, as a in plate; and the ee as in sweet j he may go through the whole work with a pronunciation so correct, that a Hindoo would understand him.
