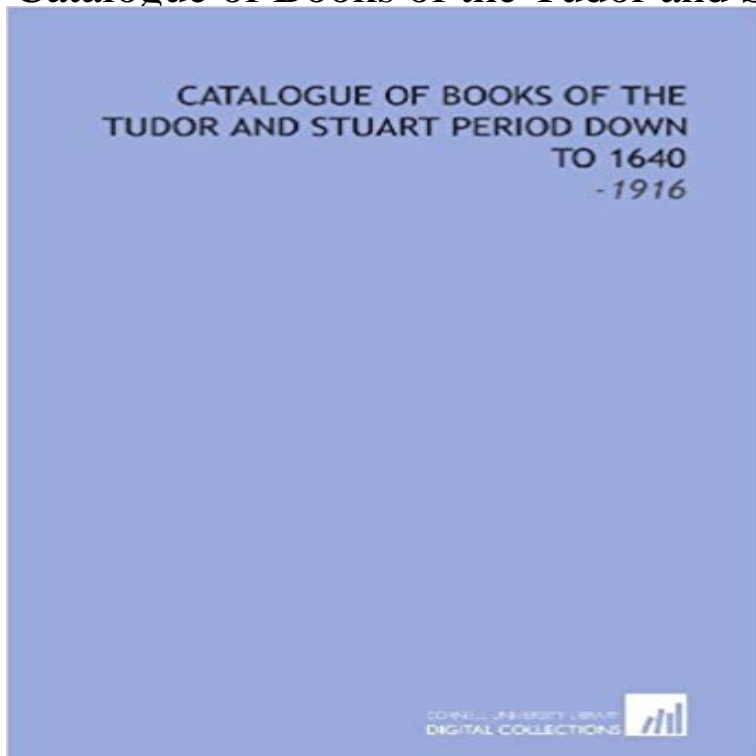


Catalogue of Books of the Tudor and Stuart Period Down to 1640: -1916
